

MINIMUM IDENTITY STANDARD – QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

COMMENCEMENT DOCUMENT *(ONE (1) IS REQUIRED)*

- Australian Birth Certificate
- Australian Passport (must be current)
- Immicard
- Document of Identity issued by DFAT
- Evidence of Residence status (Immigration status)
- Certificate of Identity issued by DFAT to refugees and non-Australian citizens for entry to Australia

PRIMARY USE IN COMMUNITY DOCUMENT *(ONE (1) IS REQUIRED)*

- Australian Drivers Licence
- Australian Marriage Certificate Issued by a state based Births Deaths and Marriage Department
- Overseas Passport (must be current)
- Proof of Age or Photo ID issued by AU Government (must be current)
- Shooters or Firearms Licence (Issued in Australia)
- Student ID Card (if Under 18)

SECONDARY USE IN COMMUNITY DOCUMENT *(TWO (2) OF THESE ARE REQUIRED)*

- Medicare Card
- Enrolment with the Australian Electoral Commission
- Document of Identity issued by DFAT
- Foreign Government Issued Documents
- Security Guard / Crowd Control Licence
- Evidence of Right to an Australian Government Benefit
- Consular Photo Identity Card
- Police Officer Photo Identity Card
- Credit Card / Debit Card
- Australian Defence Force Photo ID Card
- Council Rates Notice (showing name and current address)
- Phone Bill (showing name and current address)
- Australian Government Photo ID Card
- Trusted Referees Report
- Aviation Security Identification Card
- Bank Card
- Maritime Security Identification Card
- Credit Reference Check
- Australian Tertiary Student Photo Identity Document
- Australian secondary student photo identity document
- Certified Academic Transcript from an Australian University
- Convention Travel Document Secondary
- Certificate of Identity issued by DFAT
- Utility Bill (showing name and current address)
- Private Health Insurance Card

If you provide identity documents using a former name, such as a maiden name, or previous name or changed name you must provide evidence of the name change in addition to the four identity documents.

If one of your identity documents has your maiden name you will need to provide an official marriage certificate issued by a state Births, Deaths and Marriages Department.
